Note #1: **Make cheque payable to BC Rifle Association in Canadian or US funds.** If US currency, reduce Canadian Entry fees by 25% and final adjustment to entry fees will be made upon arrival.

Note #2: **BCRA Membership or visiting PRA Membership is required to compete in this championship. Please bring proof copy of membership card.**

Note #3: Entry is limited to 96 competitors.

Note #4: Paid markers will be used.

Note #5: Please indicate t-shirt size and quantity desired. T-shirt orders must be received by May 1<sup>st</sup>. No T-shirt orders taken after 1<sup>st</sup> May. Spare t-shirts may be for sale at the match.

Note #6: General Vokes Range does not have potable water; please bring your own drinking water.

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- Entry Fee payment is acknowledgement of acceptance of the match rules and conditions. Whining or Gaming is not acceptable during the match.

- No Alcohol use permitted on Vokes Range. Offenders will forfeit the match and be asked to leave Vokes Range immediately. The incident will be referred to BCRA Council for further action.

**Friday - 19<sup>th</sup> June:** - 1<sup>st</sup> Walk Back: 0800 - 1300. 2<sup>nd</sup> Walk Back: 1300 - 1700, max 10 rounds per range. Shooters must supply their own paper zeroing targets. Match Targets will NOT be available for zeroing.

**Saturday - 20<sup>th</sup> June:** - 2 Man Precision Rifle Team: 0800 - 1700 hrs

Ranges: 600m - 500m - 400m: Minimum of 100 rounds per competitor (200 rounds per 2-man team).

**Sunday - 21<sup>st</sup> June:** - 2 Man Precision Rifle Team: 0800 - 1700 hrs

Ranges: 100m - 200m - 300m: Minimum of 56 rounds per competitor (112 rounds per 2-man team).

**PRIZE PRESENTATIONS FOLLOWING:**

Note #1 - Competitors are requested to be at the range at least 1 hour before match commencement to assist in range set up, squadding and completing entry forms. Competitors arriving late will be served when time permits.

Note #2 - Bring ammunition for the two match days as we may move up matches from the succeeding day.

Note #3 - A match committee, chaired by the Match Director, will include one Law Enforcement competitor, one Military competitor and one Civilian competitor. Match committee decision are binding and final.

**CATEGORIES:**

**LAW ENFORCEMENT:** Any serving/auxiliary or retired Police member, Corrections Officers and Sherriff Department, either Federal or Provincial.

**MILITARY:** Any serving / retired member of the Canadian / US Forces, (Regular or Reserve) Canadian Rangers and CIL Officers.

**CIVILIAN:** Any competitor who meets Precision Rifle equipment rules.

**OPEN:** Any competitor whose rifle and equipment does not meet Precision Rifle Rules.

**TROPHIES, PRIZES AND AWARDS:**

**Plaques:** Awarded to EACH MEMBER in the top three 2 Man Teams in each of the four categories.

**Trophies:**

Top Law Enforcement Team - Trophy and 2 BC Precision Rifle Law Enforcement Gold Bullion Badges.

Top Military Team - Trophy and 2 BC Precision Rifle Military Gold Bullion Badges.

Top Civilian Team - Trophy and 2 BC Precision Rifle Civilian Gold Bullion Badges.

**PRIZE TABLE:** (Order of choice at the Prize table based on standings in BC Precision Rifle Aggregate): Top 3 individual shooters in order, top 2 Man Team in each Precision Rifle category, and then continue in order of aggregate standings until every team has performed one choice on the Prize Table.
