Course of Fire: 3 x 15 round strings at 300 yards. F-Class PR - 3 x 10 round strings:
Time Limit: 1st String: one non-convertible blow off shot, then 17 minutes for 2 convertible sighting shots and 15 rounds on score:

2nd and 3rd string: 17 minutes for 2 convertible sighting shots and 15 rounds on score:

PRESENTATION OF PRIZES FOLLOWING:

AWARDS/PRIZES:

There must be 3 entries in any given category to qualify for awards:

RIFLES: Target Rifle, F-Class-Open, F-Class FTR, F-Class PR and Bench.

CALIBRE: Any calibre up to 8mm, **no magnums or muzzle brakes allowed.**

Rules for F-Class Production Rifle (F-Class PR) Category:

- Rifle shall be centre-fire bolt action used as single shot. Removable magazines must be attached to the rifle when firing and removed from rifle when not firing for safety purposes:
- Rifle must be equipped with unmodified factory action, barrel, and trigger. Trigger may be adjusted, but no less than 1 ½ lbs. Custom stock may be used. Scopes are restricted to 25x design power:
- Total rifle weight including optics and attachments (e.g. bipod) shall not exceed 8.0 kg (18.2 lbs):
- Match Director shall have final say as to acceptability:
